## Day 1: Trust in the Divine Providence

**P1:** We pray for Fr. Milton Zonta Superior General and his Council that, following the Salvatorian charism, they might lead us towards Eternity.

**P2:** We recommend that all superiors, full of wisdom and humility, serve their brothers, the Society, the Church, as Father Founder showed us with his life.

**P3:** We pray for all leaders and governments, especially in this pandemic time.

**P1:** We recommend all the provinces of our Congregation, its pro-provinces and vicariates, every administrative unit, and every community so that, built on the Eucharist, they might be strong in practicing the love that the Divine Saviour teaches us.

**P2:** We pray for all Christians being the sign of unity and peace of the World.

**All:** Rejoice and rejoice, tormented soul, because the Creator of everything lives in you! The King of the angelic choirs comes to you; to you comes God, mighty, almighty. Rejoice and rejoice! You are visited by the King of Virgins. Rejoice and rejoice! The Lord of the angels comes to you. Rejoice and rejoice, tormented soul. You are not visited by an angel or a saint; Cherubim and Seraphim do not come to you. The King and Lord of angels and all saints come to you, King of Cherubim and Seraphim.

Rejoice and rejoice, be glad and shout for joy, because you are not visited by the Lady of virgins, but the Most High, Most Pure, King of virgins, Most Holy, Patient, Most Mighty, Gentle, Doctor of all sufferings, Saviour of the world. Dive into the ocean of your God's love!

### **Day 3: Listened to the Word of God**

**P1:** We recommend the entire Congregation of the Sisters of the Divine Saviour, Mother General with her Council, all the provinces and communities scattered all over the world. Let, following the example of Bl. Mary of the Apostles spread the Saviour's honour throughout the world.

**P2:** We pray for the sisterly vocations so that the Salvatorian charism will be nurtured by many women's hearts, pure and generous.

## Day 4: Temple of the Holy Spirit

**P1:** In our prayer, we recommend the International Community of the Divine Saviour and their mission of reaching all places with the Good News about Jesus.

**P2:** We entrust to you all laypeople so that drawing strength from the sacrament of baptism, they may strive more and more for their own salvation.

**P3:** We entrust all our Salvatorian collaborators and benefactors so that, in cooperation with us, they may discover the beauty of Christ and His Church.

**P4:** We give to those who have been harmed by our ministry. Please forgive us and strengthen our faith in them, so that our human weaknesses do not extinguish the flame of Your love in them.

**P2:** We pray for every Salvatorian sister, every brother, priest, lay Salvatorian - that our testimony would be a clear sign that there is no salvation in any other, as in Jesus Christ

**P3:** We ask that we might be people of fervent prayer, and thus also teachers of prayer for others. We pray for our fathers, mothers, grandmothers, and grandfathers.

**P3:** We also recommend each apostolate, thanks to which people progress on the way of getting to know and love Jesus.

**P4:** We pray that we will be attentive and close to those who suffer.

**P2:** We ask for all who work in ministry in prison, refugee camps, on streets.

**P3:** We humbly ask people for hope and trust in the Divine Providence.

**P4:** We pray for people being used and taken advantage of by others. We are praying for those who are suffering alone and seemed forgotten.
